It is the Policy of the North Bay Police Services Board with respect to annual reporting that:

- a) The Chief of Police, will prepare an annual report for the Board on the activities of the police service during the previous fiscal year, which includes, at a minimum, information on:
  - i. Performance objectives and indicators as set out in the business plan, and results achieved;
  - ii. Public complaints;
  - iii. The actual cost of police services; and
  
- b) Pursuant to the protocol entered into with City Counsel, this Board will be responsible for:
  - i. Making the annual report public; and
  - ii. Making the report available to council.
