It is the policy of the North Bay Police Services Board with respect to the services of a tactical unit that:

- a) this Board will contract with an external police agency to provide the services of a tactical unit, major incident commanders and crisis negotiators that is available 24 hours a day and within a reasonable response time; and:
- b) the Chief of Police, in consultation with the designated representative of the contracted police agency will:
 - i) establish procedures that set out the circumstances in which the service will be deployed, including the steps for obtaining the services and the reporting relationships; and
 - ii) ensure that the police service's major incident commanders and crisis negotiators train with the contracted agency's tactical unit.
