It is the policy of the North Bay Police Services Board with respect to major incident command services that:

- a. the police service will provide the services of a major incident commander by using its own members;
- b. the services will be available 24 hours a day and within a reasonable response time; and:
- c. the Chief of Police will:
  - i) develop procedures that address the circumstances in which the major incident commander is to be deployed;
  - ii) develop and maintain a manual on major incident command that is available to each member providing this service;
  - iii) establish a selection process for members who provide this service, including ensuring that members who provide this service meet the requirement of the Adequacy Standards Regulation;.
  - iv) ensure the ongoing training of members who provide this service; and
  - v) ensure that appropriate equipment, in accordance with the Ministry's designated equipment and facilities list, is available to members who provide this service.
