It is the policy of the North Bay Police Services Board with respect to ground search for lost or missing persons that the Chief of Police will:

- a) promote, through partnerships with emergency service providers and volunteer groups, the coordination of ground search services in the jurisdiction served by the police service;
- b) develop procedures on ground search for lost or missing persons; and
- c) ensure that search coordinators and team leaders have the knowledge, skills and abilities required to perform these functions.
