It is the policy of the North Bay Police Services Board with respect to supervision that the Chief of Police will:

- a) ensure that there is 24 hour supervision available to members of the police service;
- b) establish procedures on supervision that set out the circumstances where a supervisor must be contacted and when a supervisor must be present at an incident; and
- c) establish a selection process to ensure that members appointed permanently to supervisory positions have the knowledge, skills and abilities for the supervisory positions.
