It is the policy of the North Bay Police Services Board with respect to public order maintenance that:

1. this Board will contract with an external police agency to provide the services of a public order unit within a reasonable response time; and
2. the Chief of Police will establish procedures, in consultation with the designated representative of the contracted agency, that:
 - i.* set out the circumstances in which a public order unit may be deployed;
 - ii.* set out the steps for obtaining the services of a public order unit; and
 - iii.* address the circumstances and processes for liaising with appropriate officials for the purposes of Sections 63 – 68 of the *Criminal Code*, regarding unlawful assemblies and riot situations.
