Statistical Reports

In the absence of Deputy Chief, Scott Tod, the Chief, presented the Condensed Monthly Statistical and Revised Statistical Reports for the month of March 2016 (Revised). There were 2519 calls for service compared to 2304 calls in 2015. Of these calls 127 were to investigate motor vehicle accidents. Nine of these accidents involved injuries, with 11 persons injured. Calls for Service were reported at 6062 with 697 Criminal Offences and 6986 Police Activities logged. Overall there is an increase in calls for service and police activity with fewer criminal offences reported.
