Methodone Treatment – Presentation – Dr. Ralph Dell’Aquila

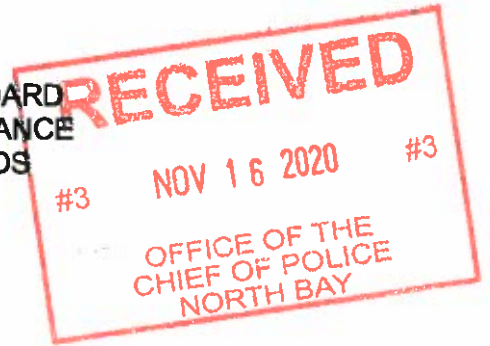

Did you know that mental illness is the leading cause of disability in Canada? The total cost per year to the Canadian economy of mental health problems is \$50 Billion or \$1,400.00 per person living in Canada. Depression is one of the most common forms of mental illness and does not discriminate. It strikes all socioeconomic, educational, and cultural backgrounds. While 1 in 5 Canadians will feel the effect of mental illness this year. It reflects approximately 15% of Canada's health care burden but only seven cents out of every public health care dollar is allocated to mental health.
