By-Law # 28: By-Law for Rescinding By-Laws and Policies

Legislative Reference / Authority

Community Safety and Policing Act (CSPA) and Regulations

1. Preamble

- a. As prescribed in the *Community Safety and Policing Act (CSPA)* and through Regulation the North Bay Police Service Board shall establish policy(ies) consistent with the *Act*, Regulation(s) and any other applicable legislation.
- b. It is the policy of the North Bay Police Service Board with respect to rescinding existing North Bay Police Service By-Laws and Policies that it will establish By-Laws and Policy(ies) that are consistent with the requirements of the *Community Safety and Policing Act*, Regulation(s) and incorporating any existing established operational and accounting practices as approved by the North Bay Police Service Board and or the Office of the Chief of Police.

2. Process

- a. Pursuant to the *CSPA* section 10 (1) the Police Service Board shall ensure that adequate and effective policing in the area for which it has policing responsibility in accordance with the needs of the population in the area and having regard for the diversity of the population in the area.
- b. Pursuant to Section 38 (1) a Police Service Board shall establish policies respecting: the administration of the police service;
 - i. The provision of adequate and effective policing in accordance with the needs of the population of the area for which it has policing responsibility;
 - ii. Disclosure by the Chief of Police of personal information about individuals;
 - iii. Disclosure of secondary activities under section 89 and decisions under that section;
 - iv. The handling of discipline within the police service;
 - v. Subject to subsection (4), the indemnification of members of the police service for legal costs; and
 - vi. Any other prescribed matters.
- c. In addition to the policies required by b. above, a Police Service Board may establish policies respecting any other matters related to the police service or the provision of policing.



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- d. On April 1, 2024 the *Community Safety and Policing Act* was enacted and it along with its' Regulations replaced the *Police Services Act RSO 1990*. To ensure compliance under the *CSPA* the following pre-April 2024 existing By-Laws and Policies listed below are hereby rescinded.
