Reporting Requirement	Chief to submit report within 120 days post an active attacker incident – subject to SIU involvement. If unable to complete report Chief to update the Board every 30 days.  Board to post report(s) to the internet.

BOARD POLICY

1. As prescribed in Ontario Regulation 393/23 the North Bay Police Service Board shall establish policy(ies) consistent with the Regulation, the *Community Safety and Policing Act* and any other applicable legislation.
2. It is the policy of the North Bay Police Service Board with respect to active attacker incidents that the Chief of Police shall establish procedures that are consistent with the requirements of the *Community Safety and Policing Act*, Regulation 393/23, and incorporating any existing investigative and operational practices as approved by the North Bay Police Service Board and or the Office of the Chief of Police
3. In adhering to the provisions, the Police Service Board shall:
  - a. Not redact any information in the report from the Chief of Police that would be required to be disclosed in response to a request for access under the *Municipal Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*;
  - b. Consult with the Chief of Police respecting any proposed redaction; and
  - c. Publish the report on the internet.
4. The Chief of Police shall ensure, that pursuant to Regulation 393/23, amendments to any existing procedures or the creation of new procedure(s) shall be made.
