BOARD POLICY

1. As prescribed in the *Community Safety and Policing Act* and through Regulation(s) the North Bay Police Service Board shall establish policy(ies) consistent with the *Act*, Regulation(s) and any other applicable legislation.
2. It is the policy of the North Bay Police Service Board with respect to court security that the Chief of Police shall establish procedures that are consistent with the requirements of the *Community Safety and Policing Act*, Regulation(s) and incorporating any existing established investigative and operational practices as approved by the North Bay Police Service Board and or the Office of the Chief of Police.
3. In addition, the Chief of Police shall;
 - a. Establish a local court security committee, to serve in an advisory capacity to the Chief of Police, comprised of representatives, at a minimum, from the police, Crown, judiciary, local bar, victim services/organizations and Courts Services – Ministry of the Attorney General;
 - b. Prepare a court security plan, in consultation with the local court security committee, that adequately addresses local needs and circumstances, and meets any statutory responsibilities; and
 - c. Ensure that police officers and special constables utilized for court security are supervised and have knowledge, skills and abilities to perform the function.
